

Computer Science PhD Breadth Component



- Each student must take classes in 5 of the 15 areas of computer science.
- Of the five different courses, one must be from the Theory area.
- Students must earn an A or B in all of these classes, and more A's than B's total.

- Attach documentation from the Area Coordinator for any approved exceptions to the published breadth list.
- In addition, each student must complete a Programming Proficiency requirement. A single class may satisfy both the Programming Proficiency requirement and a Breadth area requirement. The Programming Proficiency requirement must be fulfilled at Georgia Tech and may not be satisfied by transfer credit or advanced standing.
