Overview of Minor Requirement

In accordance with Georgia Tech's Ph.D. requirements, each student is expected to complete nine credit hours of courses constituting a Minor. A Minor can consist of courses in an area of computer science OTHER than Human-Centered Computing, or courses outside the CoC, or some combination thereof. These courses should constitute a coherent theme—i.e. somehow relate to your thesis and research.

A total of 9 semester hours of letter grade credit must be taken, maintaining a B average in the courses. Exceptions to this should be discussed with the Graduate Coordinator. Courses should be at the graduate level, but one approved 4000-level course may be utilized also. A maximum of 3 hours of guided research course credit (outside CoC) is allowed. After Program Coordinator approval, please turn in this form to the College of Computing Student Services office. It will then be submitted to the GT Graduate Studies department for final approval. You will be contacted if there are any questions.
