The total cost of studying abroad for the summer in Berlin is largely up to the individual student; however, expenses and payment deadlines associated with the program are summarized below and a reasonable estimate of total cost is \$15,750:

All students will pay a \$200 housing deposit for their stay in the residence (due March 28th), which is refundable less any
damage deductions or replacement charges. Refunded deposits will be credited to student accounts through the Bursar's
Office by the end of the following fall term.

How to pay...

Please remember that all tuition, fees (including program charge; supplemental fees; housing deposit) will be <u>charged and paid through the Bursar's Office</u> via each student's OSCAR account. Payments to a student's account are first applied towards any outstanding charges on the student's account (e.g. unpaid parking tickets), so please confirm that all outstanding charges have been reconciled to ensure timely and intended allocation of any Berlin payments. You may want to designate your payment to Summer 2022. Students will be notified by email when program charges are posted; tuition and registration fees will be assessed upon registration for summer classes.

Using Financial Aid & Scholarships...

Students can apply financial aid and scholarships to their tuition, GT mandatory fees, and Berlin program charge by coordinating in advance with the Office of Scholarships & Financial Aid and the Berlin program coordinator and by signing a promissory note as applicable. Once accepted to the program, students should email berlin@cc.gatech.edu for more information if interested.

<u>Cancellation and Refund Policy:</u> The application fee is non-refundable; students cancelling participation prior to March 6th must pay the first program fee payment of \$3,900; cancellations after this date will result in forfeiture of all anticipated or paid program fees. Additionally, Georgia Tech reserves the right to alter or cancel this program due to low enrollment, unavailability of a professor to teach a planned course, or other unforeseen circumstances. If Georgia Tech cancels the program before departure for reasons within its control, all fees paid by participants will be refunded. If Georgia Tech cancels the program before departure or while the program is in progress for reasons beyond its control, such as political unrest or danger to participants' safety, only those fees that Georgia Tech is able to have refunded by service providers will be returned to participants.
